Resource Allocation

Consistent with the North American Wildlife Conservation Model, Wild Sheep Foundation will remain neutral on resource allocation issues that do not negatively impact the wild sheep resource. WSF strongly endorses hunting as a viable use of the resource and a valuable conservation tool. However, we believe and respect allocation of hunting permits between resident and non-resident hunters is the responsibility of each state, province, or territory, unless it negatively impacts the resource or overall hunting opportunities.

We believe that the combined efforts of all stakeholders to increase wild sheep populations would result in greater access and opportunities for <u>all</u> hunters and outdoor enthusiasts. WSF supports fact-based decision making consistent with sound science-based game management. WSF welcomes the opportunity to provide information that may assist various game management organizations and agencies in making sound decisions.
