



CHADWICK RAM SOCIETY ELIGIBILITY

Annual Draw (July 15, 2026)

1.) Members must be in "good standing" to be eligible. – Members who are two years delinquent (from original pledge date) on their pledge will be notified and may lose their eligibility for society benefits including entries into CRS exclusive drawings and access to exclusive societies lounge spaces at Sheep Show® in Reno and societies receptions.

2.) If a member upgrades to a higher pledge level but cannot/chooses to not fulfill their commitment, they may be downgraded to the most recently "completed" or "paid in full" pledge level and their entries into the drawing will be based on that pledge.

Example: A completed Copper level member upgrades to bronze and makes \$1,000 in contributions toward their Bronze commitment but fails to stay current with their pledge. At the two-year mark, they will be notified and then "downgraded" to a completed Copper level member and will receive entries to the drawing based on their Copper pledge (10 total).

3.) Any Copper level member who fails to continue with their pledge and remains "delinquent" at the two-year mark (from original pledge date) will be notified and removed from the listing and any entries earned to that point will be pulled from the drawing.

Example: Someone who signs up at the Copper level and pays \$500 toward their pledge (two entries) but fails to continue with their pledge after reminders and letters of notification will be removed from the listing and will have their entries pulled from the drawing. These members will no longer have access to society lounge space at Sheep Show® or society receptions.

4.) Annual Drawing - Winning members' entries prior to the date they won will be removed from future drawings. If they upgrade and/or continue paying toward an existing pledge, those new pledge dollars will count toward the next drawing.

E.g., CRS member X won as a paid in full Silver level member. He/she has not upgraded/paid more toward an upgraded pledge; therefore, he/she will not have any entries in the next year's drawing. If he/she upgrades to Gold, any new dollars paid toward his/her new pledge will count toward subsequent drawings.

5.) Platinum level/paid in full members are maxed out of entries. Once they win, they are out of any future drawings.

6.) Living members who are in "good standing" are eligible to enter and win Chadwick Ram Society drawings.

7.) The hunt is transferrable at the discretion of the outfitter.

8.) If the winning member chooses to transfer the hunt, that member has, in effect, accepted the hunt and will lose accumulated entries to that point.

9.) WSF staff will draw two "back-up" entries in the event that the first drawn member cannot take the hunt.

10.) Ticket status will not be affected if the drawn member cannot take the hunt and immediately donates the hunt back to WSF.

11.) When a hunt is donated back, WSF reserves the right to either re-draw a winner or otherwise re-allocate the hunt.

DONATION: This is a 7-day Coues deer and mountain lion hunt for 1 hunter. Hunting lions in the mornings and Coues deer in the afternoons!

DATES: Schedule with Outfitter for Oct-Dec of 2026 through 2030, hunters' choice.

ADDITIONAL HUNTERS: Up to 3 more are welcome, check with the outfitter.

ADDITIONAL NON-HUNTERS: Welcome for \$3,000.

AMENITIES INCLUDED: Guide, meals (including non-alcoholic beverages and snacks), lodging, private property, and ranch access fees – if required, USFS and BLM permits as needed, tax, trophy fees for one Coues deer and one mountain lion; field transportation during the hunt, field processing and preparation for the butcher and taxidermist (if needed).

AMENITIES NOT INCLUDED: AZ hunting license is \$160, deer tag \$300, application fee \$45, mountain lion tag, \$75. Hunt is a draw with well over 80% draw odds year one, 100% year two and the outfitter handles all the draw paperwork.

LOCATION: Hunters fly into Phoenix or Tucson. If driving, Arivaca, AZ is your most likely destination.

ACCOMMODATION: Heated canvas cabin tents, trailers, or wall tents.
