About the Courses

INTRODUCTION TO WING SHOOTING

We begin with gun fit, eye dominance check and discuss choke and load selection, essential for various types of wing shooting.

On the trap field, you'll engage with clay presentations that replicate real quail flight—fast, low, and unpredictable—while developing effective shooting angles and reactions.

In the duck blind, instruction focuses on pass shooting vs. decoying, and shooting from seated or restricted positions.

Through classic presentations, you'll build the awareness and discipline needed for success in the blind.

Finally, on the flurry field, you'll refine footwork, stance, and swing mechanics, then apply these skills to driven target sequences—improving timing, consistency, and confidence for driven pheasant shoots.

INTRODUCTION TO PISTOL SHOOTING

This course focuses on holster draw, accurate target engagement, and effective malfunction clearing. The course combines classroom instruction with live-fire drills conducted from the holster, allowing students to practice essential skills in a safe and controlled environment. By the end of the day, students will be able to competently draw their pistol from the holster, engage targets accurately, and respond to common malfunctions with confidence.



About the Courses

HUNTER PREPARATION COURSE - RIFLE

This focused, hands-on course is designed to prepare hunters for real-world success through an emphasis on practical, hunting-specific marksmanship. Participants will engage in a multi-stage shoot built around realistic field scenarios, allowing them to refine their rifle setup, confirm zero, and build confidence in their accuracy.

Training includes shooting from alternate positions and making effective use of field equipment such as sticks, packs, rocks, and natural supports. Shooters will engage animal-shaped steel targets at realistic distances, reinforcing the fundamentals of marksmanship in a true hunting context.

Whether you're new to hunting or preparing for the season, this course ensures both you and your rifle are accurate, confident, and field-ready.





Overnight Accommodations

Rooms at Hudson Farm are self-check in at 3pm. You will be staying in the Quail House. The rooms can be locked once inside. There are no keys. You are welcome to use the gym and sauna in the lower level of the Quail building. Check out is at 11am.
