



The WSF Women Hunt™ Program will sponsor twelve women to attend the New Hunter Program course designed and delivered by the FTW Ranch in Texas.

Travel Dates: September 30 to October 6, 2021.

Course Dates: October 2-5, 2021 (4-day course.)

This experience includes:

- The cost of the FTW New Hunter Program package, valued at \$2,950, is fully sponsored by the Women Hunt™ Program
- Accommodation at Courtyard by Marriott San Antonio Riverwalk on September 30 (1 night)
- Group dinner on September 30
- Transport coach to the FTW Ranch from the Courtyard Marriott on October 1 and return to the San Antonio Airport on October 6
- Non-resident Texas hunting license and whitetail license fee
- 5-nights lodging and 4 days of instruction at the FTW Ranch and includes all meals and beverages
- Precision Rifle instruction, comfortable and proficient shooting to 300 yards
- Instruction on different hunting methods: spot and stalk, tracking, stands, using wind to your advantage, etc.
- Ethics and hunting
- North American Model of Wildlife Conservation
- Game Identification
- Shot Placement
- Field Dressing
- Butchering
- Wild Game Cooking
- Opportunity to hunt and harvest a white-tailed doe

Build camaraderie, opportunity to hunt with other women in similar circumstances, build confidence to be hunters, come out understanding the conservation model and being proponents of the importance of hunting in their lives and the world.

Each participant will share in the harvest so each one goes home with wild game, regardless of whether all are successful in their hunt. A YETI 65 QT Tundra cooler and 4lbs of YETI ice, fully donated by YETI, will be pre-shipped to the FTW Ranch for each participant to bring their wild game meat home.

Each participant will have the use of a brand new Weatherby Camilla Wilderness rifle in 6.5 Creedmoor (for right-handed shooters) or a Weatherby Mark V Weathermark LT in .257 WM (for left-handed shooters) topped with the new and superb Leica 3-18x44 Amplus 6 scope, and 200 rounds of ammunition.

Each participant will have the opportunity, if they choose, to purchase their rifle/scope package at a greatly reduced price with a BOYT hard travel case so they can bring their rifle/scope package home.

In addition, each participant will receive a pair of Kenetrek women's Mountain Extreme boots, assorted camouflage clothing, a WSF and Women Hunt™ logo clothing, swag, a commemorative YETI 20 oz Rambler, and a Weatherby Swag Bag.
